

From My Heart to Yours.....

We are very excited to be hosting Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University beginning in the month of February. Our planning team is convinced that this 9-week series will bring a transformation to your finances and your ability to deal with money in a Biblical manner.

Today, I would like us to begin thinking about our money management and how we can attain a higher degree of financial freedom in the new year. So, as a prelude to Dave Ramsey's class I would like to share with you four Biblical principles of money management from the book of Proverbs.

Principle Number One: Keep Good Records

Proverbs 27:23-24

Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds; for riches do not endure forever, and a crown is not secure for all generations.

First of all, you need to know where your money comes from and where it goes. The Bible calls this the principle of accounting. In Biblical times they kept records of their goats, sheep, etc. Today we deal with stocks, bank accounts, assets, and real estate.

Someone once said, "My assets are in a liquid state—everything is going down the drain." If you follow Solomon's advice and keep good records then you stand a better chance of your money not going down the drain.

Principle Number Two: Plan Your Spending

Proverbs 21:5

The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as haste leads to poverty.

Dwight Eisenhower once said, "Plans are nothing. Planning is everything." Solomon would agree. He said, "The plans of the diligent lead to profit as surely as haste leads to poverty." (Proverbs 21:5)

What is this verse saying? One of the things it's saying is financial freedom is not determined by how much you make. That's one of the biggest myths in our society. Some of you think, "If I just make a little bit more then I'd be financially free." You will not. If you can't live on what you're making right now you won't then. Why? Because your yearnings will always exceed your earnings. You're always going to want more than you make. Always. Your yearnings will always exceed your earnings.

My friends, you need to have a financial plan, even a budget, you need to have some financial goals. When it comes to our money, many of us need desperately to harness the

power of advanced decision making, reel in spending and have a solid financial game plan.

Principle Number Three: Save for the Future.

Proverbs 21:20

The wise store up choice food and olive oil, but fools gulp theirs down.

I like the New Living Translation of Proverbs 21:20 'The wise have wealth and luxury, but fools spend whatever they get."

During some phases of our life, saving can be more challenging. Especially when we are living paycheck to paycheck. But it's still a Biblical principle that will help you toward greater prosperity. Saving gets your money working for you rather than you working for your money.

Principle Number Four: Eliminate Debt

Proverbs 22:7

The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is slave to the lender.

It's no coincidence that there are 4 letters in the word debt, because if you are or ever have been in debt, you know by experience that debt is a four-letter word – it's agonizing and it's painful. As a matter of fact, the Bible says debt is like wearing shackles in prison.

As a general rule, if you're spending more than 10 percent of your monthly income on consumer debt like credit cards and car payments, you've overextended yourself. You need to think about rearranging your priorities. It's better yet to pay off the credit card bills every month, allowing you to invest money into your future and into God's work around the world.

Managing our money is not an option. It's something we all have to do. You will have the most success doing it if you follow biblical guidelines for money management. That means we should keep good records, plan our spending, save consistently and eliminate debt.
