The mission of the Personal Needs Pantry is to help families in our community who are struggling with job loss, financial instability or poverty to maintain personal dignity and a healthy home environment by providing basic personal hygiene and household cleaning items.

We accept referrals from Salvation Army, The Food Center, local churches, and various social service agencies. Persons self-referring to the Pantry must bring identification for everyone living in their household.

Because our program relies solely on donations, not all items are available at all times. We try to keep a good selection and replenish as often as possible.
